We are very grateful for your support this year. We could not fulfill our goal of reducing the number of unwanted cats and dogs by spaying and neutering without your volunteerism and donations. God bless you.

This year was a record-breaker for the number of total cats and dogs "fixed" through our program -- 456 cats and 80 dogs have been spayed or neutered and we still have the month of December to add to those numbers. That brings our grand total to 1,836 cats and 242 dogs since September 2010, when we established SNAP.

In addition to our yard sale fundraisers, we hosted our first Basket Bingo. It was a big success and we are planning one again next year. More than 100 people played Bingo or stopped by to eat or visit with friends. It was a lot of work and a lot of fun.

The **Spay Neuter Assistance Program of Gallia County** is a non-profit 501c3 all volunteer organization. In cooperation with Riverbend Animal Clinic and French Town Veterinary Clinic, SNAP makes it possible for qualifying pet-owners to get their dogs and cats spayed or neutered. We also help get free-roaming cats fixed by trapping and returning them to their original location, providing we have funds available. We are all about **prevention**. We encourage pet adoption, and by preventing unwanted litters of puppies and kittens the opportunity increases for adult dogs and cats to get loving, responsible owners. Cat overpopulation is a huge problem in Gallia County as cats can breed as young as four and a half months and can have three litters in one year. Gallia County has no cat shelter, which compounds the problem.

We do not receive any funds from the government. We raise money through yard sales and fundraisers. Monetary donations are welcome and appreciated and are tax-deductible in accordance with IRS directives. They may be mailed to P.O. Box 86, Gallipolis, OH 45631.

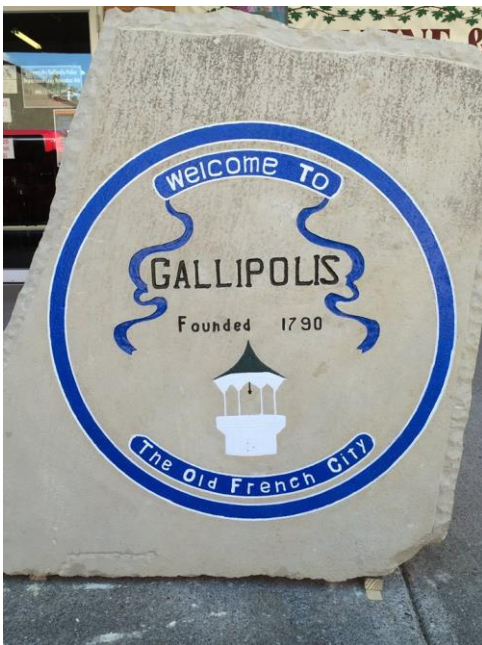
